Introducing IRIC's New School Social Worker (SSW)

Welcome to Karina Nottveit, our new School Social Worker. She comes to us from Peace River School Division and is looking forward to getting to know the students and staff of IRIC this year.

As IRIC's School Social Worker, Karina will provide short term supportive assistance to students, guardians and/or their families who are experiencing difficulties and require support at school, home, and/or in the community. Her role also may include universal programming in the classrooms and small-group work. To kick start this fall, Karina will be facilitating a Back-to-School Social and Emotional Wellness Unit to help all students transition successfully back to school and promote growth and resilience. This service is free of charge to all IRIC students. Karina works within the limits of the school, therefore does not perform assessments or provide advice regarding custody matters or legal issues. Student referrals to Karina can be made by parents/guardians, school educational staff, self-referrals, or peers.

Undertanding School Fees

Grade 4, 5 and 6 School Fees will be on our website for the 2020-21 school year. You can expect to purchase a lock for your child's locker and you may consider purchasing a Chromebook for your child to use here at school. Please see this link for more information: Parent Purchase Purchasing a Chromebook is not a requirement however, we do encourage student owned devices.

School Lock

\$9.29

Each student is issued a lock at the beginning of grade 4. The student owns the lock and will take the lock with them when they leave IRIC. This cost will only be charged in Grade 4 or for replacements of lost locks. It is expected that students purchase the lock through the school. This allows the office to be able to open lockers should the need arise. If a lock is faulty and stops working we will exchange the lock for a new one, free of charge.

PBL Fee

\$30.00

Each student will be participating in two Project Based Learning (PBL) experiences. This fee is for project work related to Career and Technology Foundations (CTF) outcomes for grade 4-6. Money collected may be used to bring in speakers or experts for the project launch or the culmination of the project to further enhance learning and programming. In the past, costs that have been incurred for these types of projects have included: poster boards, rolls of tape, manila tag, art supplies, materials for the holiday markets, presentations from 'Zed' Science, etc.

Technology Fee

\$25.00

This fee covers costs of online learning tools and subscriptions, apps and/or enhancements, and software. Subscriptions to learning software, such as Reflex Math, can be accessed at home allowing parents to further support their students learning and development. The fee also covers repairs and maintenance on school owned resources such as grade team ipads, covers/protectors, power bars, extension cords, SD cards and other consumable items.



 Once you have successfully created an account on the Parent Purchase website, you will get access to a made for Wolf Creek selection of Chromebooks, accessories, and warranty options.

 Once you have completed adding items to your virtual "shopping cart" and you choose to checkout, you will be asked to enter some personal information which is important for warranty, delivery, and set up of each Chromebook.






